Semi Vertical Grain (SVG)

Graded to the best face and two edges

Semi Vertical Grain (SVG) is a grade selected for a particular grain orientation. This guideline is designed to demonstrate the type of grain orientation allowed in this grade.

Specifications

- A combination of vertical grain (VG) and semi vertical grain (SVG) material allowed within each pack.
- Transition from vertical to semi vertical allowed along a length.
- Up to 40% of width or length may be transitional from vertical grain (encompassing SVG) to crown cut (flatsawn).
- Product with >40% flatsawn grain orientation not allowed.
- Further visual grading according to specified grade e.g. Select, Clear 2, Premium.

Typical products: Smooth SVG Decking, SVG Cladding.




Indicative Grain Orientation Range

Semi vertical grain






Semi vertical grain transitional to flat sawn edge <40%
